Project Budget (30 points)

- What is your budget?
- What are the other sources of funding for the project? (50% cash match required)
- Please list any in-kind resources that you will use.

Outcomes (10 points)

- How will you measure the project's success?
- In what ways will this make a positive impact on Agriculture?
- In what ways will this make a positive impact on your chapter, affiliate or AAW?

Upon completion of project please submit a report outlining the specific details of your project outcomes including all qualitative and quantitative data. This will be due 30 days after completion and should be submitted via email.
